### Directions to the Rahr Memorial School Forest

Address: 11617 Sandy Bay Road, Two Rivers

Go to Two Rivers. Drive north on Highway O through Point Beach State Forest about 6 miles. Turn left (west) as O turns into County V. Drive 1/4 miles. Turn right on Sandy Bay Road (narrow dirt road). School forest is 1/4 mile ahead on the right.

NOTE: HWY 42 is closed in Two Rivers, HWY 42 can be accessed through VV.
