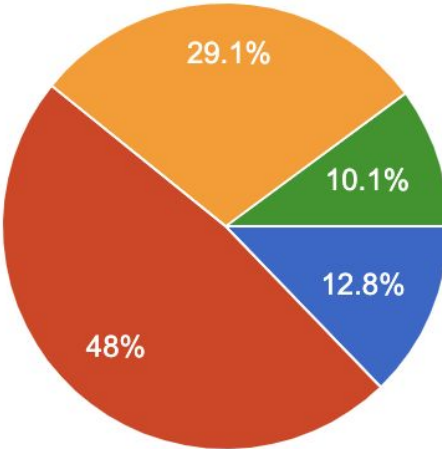

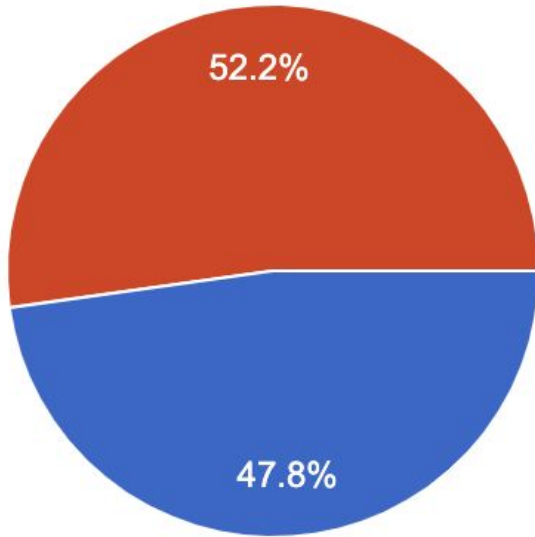


# Top 5 Concerns of the Staff

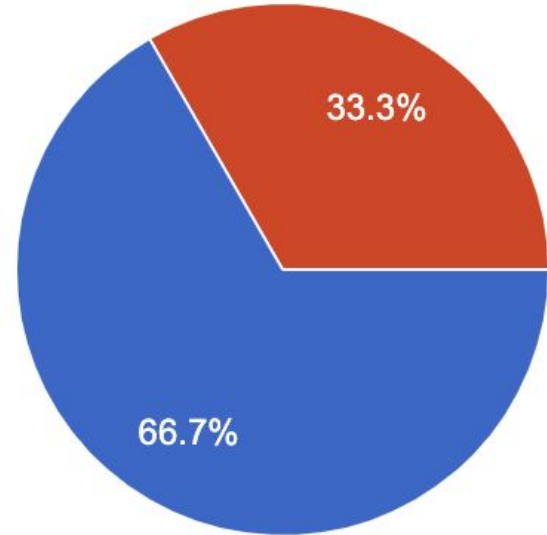
1. Enforcement of staff and/or students not following the implemented health and safety protocols

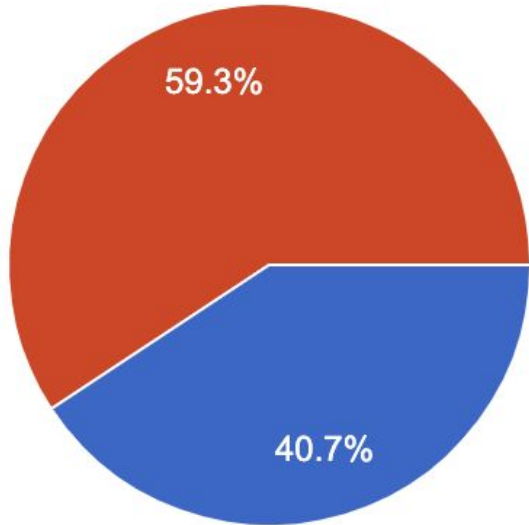

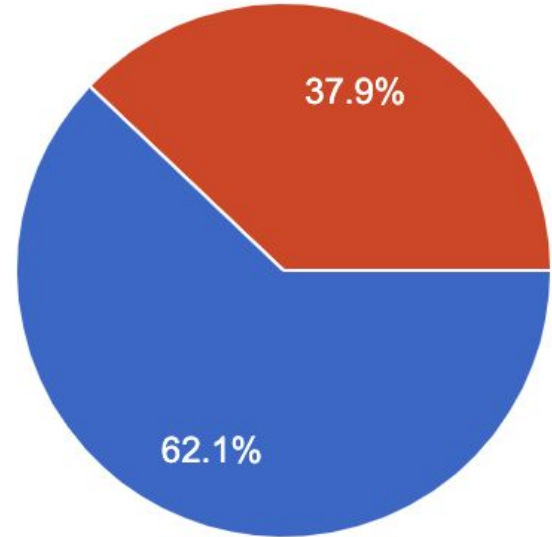
